Welcome to Zero Escape

Welcome to the **Zero Escape Network**—a regional movement bringing communities together to prevent plastic waste from escaping into landfills and the environment.

As a **Network Member**, you are the local connection between Zero Escape and your community. You will help turn awareness into participation, participation into plastic recovery, and recovered plastic into meaningful community value.

Core Mission

Zero Escape Network Members act as **local anchors** to close the loop on plastic pollution by transforming community plastic packaging waste into **durable, useful public infrastructure**.

Key Services & Responsibilities – 4-Stage Loop

1. Drive Regional Awareness

Educate local schools, businesses, neighbourhoods, and community groups on source segregation. Encourage communities to recognise flexible plastics and multi-layered wrappers as **valuable recoverable resources rather than waste**.

2. Lead Collection

Establish local wrapper drop-off points and coordinate community collection drives. Work with residents, schools, businesses, and community organisations to collect, clean, and properly segregate post-consumer wrappers.

3. Power the Pipeline

Channel all collected and segregated wrapper waste directly to designated **Zero Escape processing facilities**, ensuring that recovered material enters the recycling and transformation pipeline.

4. Deliver Infrastructure

Help bring recycled products back into the local community. These may include **school furniture, park benches, public sanitation units, and other civic infrastructure**, creating a visible local impact from the waste collected.

Essential Agreement Terms

Category	Key Highlights
Status & Role	Network Members operate as independent regional anchors/partners and are not legal employees or binding agents of Zero Escape.
Compensation	Compensation may be structured through stipends, per-kg collection rates, output-based milestones, or a combination of these, to be finalised based on the region and scope of work.
Conduct & Safety	Members must follow Zero Escape's prescribed hygiene, storage, segregation, transportation, and material-handling protocols. Collection volumes and activities must be accurately reported through designated reporting tools.
Termination	Either party may terminate the engagement with written notice for convenience. Zero Escape may terminate the engagement immediately in cases of serious misconduct, safety violations, misuse of resources, or breach of agreed protocols.
Legal Note	These terms are provided as an informational draft framework. The final Network Member Agreement should be reviewed by appropriate local legal counsel before execution.
